

1 Proposal Introduction

This application relates to the extension of an existing garden shed, located at the bottom of the rear garden to No.5 The Grove. The existing shed is a single storey building, constructed from brickwork outer leaf with a traditional slate and lead flashed sloping roof.

The shed is located next to the garden wall, which forms part of the Listing at No.5 The Grove.









2 Proposed footprint and materials


The proposed extension will follow the built line of the existing shed and will match the construction materials, including a complementary brick outer leaf and slate roof with lead flashings and painted fascia boards. The extension will be used as storage for garden equipment and furniture.

A cavity between the existing and new construction fabric will allow opportunity for ventilation and air flow, whilst making a minimal impact on the adjacent structure. Two newly planted bushes will be relocated elsewhere in the garden to make way for the new building footprint.
