

The evidence submitted (confirmation of capacity) to discharge condition 27 is out of date and contains figures that are different from the current application. The confirmation of capacity letter is dated 26/02/21, however, such notifications carry a 12 month validity, or a maximum of 3 years with planning approval. The confirmation of capacity also states that the development is 8,280m2, however the development is now stated as 46,468m2, therefore we are unable to support the discharge of the condition until capacity for the larger development is confirmed.
