The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 Reason for Refusal -

The proposed boundary treatment, including timber panel fencing and gates and brick piers with stone coping, by reason of its excessive height, design and materials, would be out of character with the lower front boundary treatments present within the surrounding area, and harm the appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017, and policies SD1 (Refurbishment of existing building stock), SD2 (Redington

Frognal conservation area) and SD4 (Redington Frognal character) of the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan 2021.

2 Reason for Refusal -

The proposed outbuilding, given its positioning and associated visibility, would result in loss of openness and erosion of the landscape character afforded by the garden to the streescene in this location thereby failing to preserve the character and appearance of the Redington Frognal Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017 and policies SD2 (Redington Frognal Conservation Area), SD4 (Redington Frognal Character) and SD5 (Dwellings: Extensions and garden development) of the Redington Frognal Neighbourhood Plan 2021.
