

Kingswood Court replacement entrance doors

The planning application is to replace two sets of life expired single glazed timber entrance doors. The doors are not visible from the road or pavement (images 1 & 2), are set back in a large, covered porch area (3mx3m) and are only accessible and visible once you have entered Kingswood court's private car park.

The existing doors are both insecure and have poor thermal performance (images 3 & 4)

The replacement doors are double glazed thermally broken aluminium, and almost identical in fenestration to the existing - apart from the absence of the mid-rails. This design decision to not retain the mid-rail was made to both afford more natural light to enter the lobby area and provide continuity with the vertical lines of the stepped grey London stock brick work that surround the doors. The grey colour was also chosen to stay in keeping with London stock brick tones and complement the original period style internal decorations (images 5 & 6). We feel the doors both preserve and enhance the blocks period style and appearance as well as provide substantial energy efficiency improvements.
