1 Reasons for granting approval of details:
Condition 4 requires the submission of 'details of replacement door and windows' prior to work commencing on site.

The Council's Conservation Officer has confirmed that the submitted details of the front door and aluminium framed windows contained in the drawings '442AP\_C1 SH3 Rev A, 442AP\_C1 SH2 Rev A' are considered acceptable and therefore condition 4 of planning permission 2024/5399/P can be discharged.
