RE: Planning Application 2024/3069/P 24 Burgess Hill London NW2 2DA

I am writing to **OBJECT** to the revised plans to the above application, on the grounds of loss of natural light. Although the plans have been modified, under the revision there would still be a significant loss of light to the neighbouring property at 26 Burgess Hill. This loss of daylight and sunlight will have a detrimental effect on the quality of life of the owners of that property.

I would also like to **OBJECT** to the revised plans on the grounds of the proposed extension being located far too close to the neighbouring property, being only a matter of a few inches from the house next door, and completely obscuring their view. Furthermore, the large scale of the proposed extension would render 26 Burgess Hill to be totally out of keeping with the design of the surrounding architecture, as the proposed extension fails to respect the historical architectural character and aesthetic of the surrounding properties in the street.

With regard to the proposed basement element of the planning application, although this part of the application has not been revised, I maintain my objections to this basement development.
