Proposed Work:

IN GROUNDS (SEE PLAN): 1 x Lime (T1) - Reduce crown to previous pruning points, approx. 4m reduction. Remove epicormic shoots from base of tree.

- 1 x Lime (T2) Reduce crown to previous pruning points, approx. 3m reduction. Remove epicormic shoots from base of tree.
- 1 x Lime (T3) Reduce crown to previous pruning points, approx. 2m reduction. Remove epicormic shoots from base of tree.
- 1 x Rose bushes (T9) Reduce height to approx. 1m from ground level.
- 1 x Thorny Olive (T10) Reduce height to approx. 2m from ground level.
- 1 x Lilac bush (T11) Reduce height to approximately 1m from ground level and cut back from path.
- 1 x mixed Shrubs (holly, pyracantha, bay, thorny olive) (T12) trim back from path with hedge cutters and clear ground 0.6m into beds and lift to 0.6m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 17 February 2025 and does not wish to object.
