I represent the language school opposite. I note that there is a door onto the passage. I would like to see a restriction placed on the cafe against the use of any outside tables or chairs. There is quite a heavy footfall to the school and it is an important access route for the emergency services and should not be obstructed. If customers use this entrance it should be clear that they cannot smoke in this area as it is close to the entrance of the school and flats. I'm also concerned that there may be extra demand on the bicycle storage area. Perhaps this facility could be extended by the Council. Finally, I am a little concerned that the plant on the room may be smelly and also noisy which could disturb lessons in the school and would seek reassurance on this point.
