					2. The RPCAAC notes that this section of the land beween the Outer Circle and Prince Albert Road was the route of the Regent's Canal until drained and filled during the London Blitz and after. In it's earlier form it constituted a 'wooded valley' admired by John Nash himself. The mix of trees on the site is significant in the history of the Park and its surroundings, and it is important that the felled tree is replaced, as suggested, by two trees, of suitable type in terms of the local ecology.
					3. The RPCAAC is very concerned that no work be permitted to trees, and associated shrubs, during the breeding and nesting season of birds. We would expect any consents to reference the legal protection of birds especially while breeding and nesting.
