There is insufficient information provided in the application. There are no indications of heights, specifically to the top of the roof construction from the existing parapet, or to the top of the flank/party walls or chimneys.

The back elevation shows the V-shape of the brickwork built up; this should remain as a memory of the butterfly roof and follow the rhythm of the terrace, even though No. 4 was built over and the butterfly roof demolished.

The numbers on the rear elevations photograph wrongly identify the properties, ie the property identified as No.6 should be No.10 and so on.
