Subject: Objection to Museum Street Developments

To whom it may concern,

I am writing because, in the proposed changes to Museum Street, I am advised that:

1. The single bay does not provide sufficient capacity for deliveries and waste collection for such a large development. This will lead to queueing and parking on the street leading to traffic disruption in an already congested area and air pollution.
2. The hours of operation are too long and will cause undue disturbance for residents.
3. The air pollution will be detrimental to the health and well-being of the residents as will the noise at unsocial hours.
4. Allowing street collection for plastic sacks of rubbish in Vine Lane is insanitary and a retrograde step which will encourage vermin to the area.
