Reason for approving details:

Condition 4 of planning permission 2024/4095/P requires that the submission

and approval of drawings and materials of the replacement curved windows to be installed in the rear wing.

The submission includes photos of the glass panes which are to be replaced. It should be noted that new windows are not proposed. As such, drawings and materials of the window frames are not required. These will remain the same.

Also submitted is a Method Statement which confirms the use of 4mm thick curved glass (the curvature is shown).

The Method Statement includes the scope of work, materials and tools required, safety precautions, preparation, removal of broken glass, installation of new glass, window repairs, cleaning and final inspection, handover and signoff and conclusion.

The submitted details would ensure the retention of curved glass planes within the existing curved glass windows which are to be retained and the character and appearance of the Belsize Park Conservation Area would therefore be preserved.

As such, the proposals comply with policies D1 and D2 of the LB Camden Local Plan 2017. The proposals also comply with the London Plan 2021 and the NPPF 2024.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with the National Planning Policy Framework.
