**Extension to Rear Basement, 6 South Hill Park, NW3 2SB**

I am a long-term resident of the South Hill Park Conservation Area, The Statement for which declares. “The unique relationship of the dwellings to Parliament Hill and the Heath is also a principle feature of Conservation Area. Street and garden trees, as well as mature shrubs, provide some softening of the fairly dominant built form.”

The proposal for this huge basement extension would destroy the relationship of the buildings to the heath, obliterate the view of the trees, and destroy mature shrubs in 3 gardens. The proposed extension, in its height as well as length, would make a mockery of the conservation area statement, and result in overdevelopment in an already fragile zone. On that basis I object.
