

## **Trial Hole**

The proposal is that the existing brickwork wall, highlighted in blue on the adjacent plan is to be removed and new steel frame introduced. The rooms on either side of this wall are currently used for storage but the proposal is to use the room as a dance studio.

The bottom beam of the new steel frame may require lowering into the top of the foundation of the wall and therefore the junction between the existing floor and foundation this required. It is assumed that the current floor is a ground bearing concrete slab. A trial hole must be dug in the corner of the room to expose to find the depth, size and condition of the foundation and the relationship it has to the floor structure. It should be noted that the building is grade II listed. The photographs below show the current floor and which is used for storage.
