- 2. TfL has no concerns with the proposal for window manifestation.
- 3. If L understands that both the hanging projecting sign and door fascia sign would be non-illuminated, nevertheless the following lighting advice is outlined below for reference:
- Any illumination for the proposed sign must be below the limit set out in the Institute of Lighting Professionals (ILP) publication: "The Brightness of Illuminated Advertisements" (PLG05/23, 2023).
- The proposed signs must not have any intermittent light source, moving feature, animation or exposed cold cathode tubing.

The proposal as it stands would not have an unacceptable impact on the TLRN, therefore TfL has no objections.
