I'm writing regarding the above application.

We are grave owners on the mound and had not been consulted on the proposals for the gardeners building at any stage prior to the submission of an application. This is the case for other grave owner on the mound that I've met since.

Despite a large and diverse community liaison group and numerous consultation events, nobody from the mound (as far we have ascertained) was invited to attend.

I'm enclosing a summary of the objections received from other mound grave owners to date. These are from your own website but helps to understand the strength of their individual cases. These objections are recent as we were only recently notified of the proposals by Highgate Cemetery themselves.

I'm also attaching some initial observations on the scale and massing of the building and would like to suggest a meeting with yourself and the conservation officer on site so that you can see for yourself that the scale and massing of the proposed garden building next to the only active burial site in the cemetery is wholly inappropriate.

In the meantime I would be grateful if you could regard this email and it's attachments as a formal objection to the proposals for the Gardeners Building only.

I've cc'd other mound grave owners who we've met since march and we look forward to hearing from you.
