Design Principles

Design

The new infill roof extention will match those approved and built at 11, 12, 13 and 14 Reeds Place and also many adjacent on Reeds Place.

The roof terrace railings have been set in from the sides and rear to limit any over looking and to affect the amenity of the neghbouring properties.

Materials

New roof tiles to infill to match existing with Velux style rooflights.

Black painted galvanised metal railings to roof terrace.

New door to be painted timber with vertical and horizontal bard to match existing windows.

Access

The access to the property will remain through the existing front door and unaffected by the works.
