## For the attention of the Tree Officer

I am writing to give my full support for the current application to crown reduce by 3 metres the Holm Oak in the front garden of 104 Haverstock Hill.

The tree was given a similar approval for a 3 metre crown reduction back in 2011 (Application 2461) on the grounds that the tree roots causing subsidence to the entrance porch. Further 30% crown reductions were approved in 2013 (Application 2697), 2018 (Application 5460) and 2023 (Application 0671).



The earlier 2023 application was made in response to the above cracks in the entrance porch to 104 Haverstock Hill which appeared due to the severe summer drought of 2022.

In light of the current climate change variations it would seem essential that the previous time gap of 5 years between the crown reductions should now as a precautionary measure be reduced to 2 years.

For the above reason I am sure that the 30% crown reduction as soon as possible would be in everybody's best interest.
