This is the true purpose of the cemetery. This seems to have been forgotten in the proposals which place a tool store/ toilet adjacent to the graves existing and those that will come. This facility may be needed for staff and tourists but why is in not in the main tourist areas away from active graves. The facility appears to be larger than is necessary, placed insensitively in least appropriate area of the Cemetery, visually intrusive to those visiting relatives graves, and likely to generate footfall that will affect the whole Mound atmosphere. I sincerely hope that this misjudgement can be rectified so that the sanctity of the 'active' area of the Cemetery is not sacrificed for the needs of tourists.
