					The CAAC has no objection to the increased number of tables in the external area.
					The CAAC has no objection to the fence as constructed, which follows the stepped form of the wall on which it stands.
					The CAAC objects to the pergola, which fails to follow the stepped profile of the boundary structures and as a result forms an obtrusive element in the relationship of the pub and its garden to it townscape setting. The pergola might be acceptable if relocated within the external area, perhaps closer to the railway wall.
