2025/1806/T	Jean-Baptiste Rancon	60 Hodford Road  NW11 8NJ London	13/05/2025 14:13:18	OBJ	<p>We object to the felling of the Sycamore Tree (T3) to ground level.</p> <p>The council in the last few years has allowed the felling of two of the three secular trees nearby, including a very similar tree at 30 Glenilla Rd: the tree at 30 Glenilla Rd was supposed to be replaced by similar greenery according to the decision at the time, but nothing has been planted, and the Council has done no monitoring or enforcement of its order.</p> <p>The reasons given in this case seem entirely spurious: (1) The 'rear boundary fence' the tree is bordering on is a light wooden structure that certainly has not compromised the health of the tree itself. (2) We don't see what 'concrete foundation' they refer to.</p> <p>It is a blooming, healthy tree with a long life ahead. A mature, vintage sycamore visible from Belsize Park Gardens and Glenilla Rd, with a beautiful crown, which has high amenity value.</p> <p>I would suggest this tree is protected by a TPO.</p> <p>Thank you.</p>
