The building is also of historic and architectural importance and to change the shape of this building would be wrong. The proposed windows are much larger than the neighbours dormer windows. Any windows should be in the smaller size of the other windows in the roofline and not match the large size windows of the first floor of 1 Raglan street. Architecturally, the scale of the proposed windows is too big. As the owners of 26 Anglers Lane, the application is inaccurate where it says on page 8 under privacy considerations 'it does not create overlooking concerns for neighbouring properties' ie inferring that these windows will not overlook anyone. The rear dormer window will directly overlook our roof terrace, which is our only outside private space.
