EASTERN HORSE TUNNEL

This is the entrance to the Eastern Horse Tunnel, built in 1856 to provide a safe route for horses working in the goods yard. The tunnel linked the stables with the goods yard, passing beneath railway goods sidings and skirting the Wine and Beer Vaults. One end, Horse Tunnel Market, is now part of Camden Stables Market.
