I cannot find how to add my comment/objection to this new planning application by Leyland. May 19 is the closing date but it is not midnight yet so I should be able to comment:

*I vigorously object to the illuminated signs outside Letalnd. This shop is in a conservation area and is situated in lovely tree lined Haverstock Hill. There are many little individual shops in this parade and it is a friendly, local area. Many tourists stop for coffee, cinema or are simply on their way to the Heath - large illuminated signage is not in character with this area and is offensive to the eye. The startlingly huge blue graphics already on the windows and outside the shop are totally out of keeping. Large illuminated signs will stick out like a sore thumb in this area. They are ugly and light polluting and will disturb any birdlife in the trees close by. This conservation area is not suitable for garish illuminated lighting.*
