I think we need a more definitive/specific response to address this:

The report states that "Other options to connect to the water mains had been considered but were not possible." These options are not listed in the report and the reasons why are not provided. We are unclear if Thames Water have been asked. The only option for which a reason from Thames Water is given, is that the pipe to the East (which comes from the marked T junction) is private. There is no other comment from Thames Water on any of the other options. Given the number of businesses that surround Princes Circus and are supplied by Thames Water, it would be extraordinary if there were no other possible options to connect the Fountain to a water supply without digging up Shaftesbury Avenue..... Therefore, we are going to need additional information that <u>all</u> of the potential connection points have been looked at and an explanation in greater detail why the only feasible one of those is Shaftesbury Avenue.

Would Thames Water be saying that all these other businesses would be served from the mains the other side of Shaftesbury Avenue and if any new connection were required ,e.g. to a new residential or business unit created within the block the only available option would be an entire new pipe connection from that mains going under Shaftesbury Avenue? If you have that evidence with an explanation of why this is the case please can it be forwarded? Otherwise can you go back to Thames Water and clarify *in greater detail why the only feasible [option] is Shaftesbury Avenue*?
