Condition 7 (Construction Management Statement) of planning permission 2023/0534/P requires a construction management statement (CMS) to be submitted. A cover letter and CMS have been submitted. These have been reviewed by Council's Transport Planner who requested some updates to the CMS which has been updated accordingly. It is considered that the revised CMS is sufficient, and as such, it is recommended that Condition 7 is discharged.

The full impact of the development has already been assessed. The proposed

details would not have a harmful impact on the local transport network and the amenity and safety of pedestrians and other road users.

As such the submitted details demonstrate that the proposed development would be in general accordance with policy T3 of the London Borough of Camden Local Plan 2017.

2 It is noted that conditions 4 (living roof) and 6 (method statement) of planning permission 2023/0534/P, granted on 09/05/2023 are currently under consideration through 2025/1513/P. There are no other conditions that require details to be submitted.
