## **Listed Building Consent Granted**

St Stephen's Church Pond Street London NW3 2PP

Proposal:

Removal of decayed decorative stonework to north elevation at high level (Retrospective).

Drawing Nos: Site location plan; high level stone features location plan (nave floor plan); London Stone Conservation Inspection report (dated 12/12/2013); supporting photographs (damage from fallen stone cross; photographs of unstable items in situ prior to removal; photographs of locations after removal of items); covering letters (dated 18/12/2013 and 14/02/2014).

The Council has considered your application and decided to grant Listed Building Consent subject to the following condition(s):

## Conditions And Reasons:

1 The works hereby permitted shall be begun not later than the end of three years from the date of this consent.



Reason: In order to comply with the provisions of Section 18 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.

2 All new work and work of making good shall be carried out to match the original work as closely as possible in materials and detailed execution.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

3 The works hereby approved are only those specifically indicated on the drawing(s) referred to above.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

- The following items shall be retained on site and stored in a secure place until their reinstatement within three years, unless otherwise agreed in writing with the Local Planning Authority and English Heritage:
  - a) Easternmost figure on North Transept gable;
  - b) Cross to centre of North Transept gable;
  - c) Cross to the centre of the North Porch gable.

Reason: In order to safeguard the special architectural and historic interest of the building in accordance with the requirements of policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policy DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
