The proposed replacement windows, due to their inappropriate design and material type, would fail to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of the host building and the wider streetscene, contrary to policies CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the Camden Core Strategy and to policy DP24 (Securing high quality design) of Camden's Local Development Framework
