					The corner garden is a sensitive site, located adjacent to the Grade II Listed Willow Cottages with their uniform line of boundary walls. The railings should be restored to the original configuration. Furthermore, permission to use this area as a car parking space (see: 2013/7388/P) should be refused. We urge the Council to refuse this application.
