This application is virtually unreadable; no indications are given as to which railings are concerned, or what other work may be involved.

This is not surprising. This is the 6<sup>th</sup> application to F which we (and many adjoining neighbours) have had occasion to object in the past 2 years. Viz:

All of these related to repeated attempts by the applicant to defend/justify unacceptable and unapproved development on this prominent site in the centre of Hampstead. This application might relate to one aspect of these unapproved issues: carparking on an area of front garden, access to which is obtained across the line of a boundary fence, long removed.

We repeat: Enforcement action must be taken to rectify multiple infringements, of which the removal of boundary fencing is one.

Please refuse, and enforce.
