The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The air-conditioning condensers on the rear elevation, by reason of their number, materials, location and size, are detrimental to the special architectural interest of the listed building and terrace and harmful to the character and appearance of the conservation area, contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and



conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and policies DP24 (Securing High Quality Design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Development Policies Development Plan.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
