They cite a similar structure a couple of houses along - this structure is discreet and totally in keeping with the character and architecture of the houses. The one they have erected is ugly, badly built (the whole thing is wonky) and is not painted grey as they state in their application. It is white with irregular strips of wood, possibly some weird mock Tudor look intended (?) but with white upvc door and window frames, and black plastic guttering/drainage - the whole structure being a total mess architecturally. Please keep to simple grey asphalt like the one further along - discreet and in tune with it's surroundings.
