REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

(TPO Ref: C60) FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Lime - Cut down.

The Council has considered your application dated 08 November 2013 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The Lime tree is highly visible from the public realm and is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area. The application alleges that the tree is the cause of subsidence at the adjacent property. The report submitted with the application contains no evidence linking the tree to the damage. Evidence should include the identification of roots below foundations, soil analysis demonstrating soil desiccation and crack/level monitoring over a sufficient period to demonstrate progressive movement linked to the moisture usage of the tree in question.



The application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and preserve the character of the conservation area.
