## **Corner of the Arrival Square**

The Community Arch in the plinth of Plot B is visible at the corner of the square. The arched form is intended to be easily recognisable to visitors. Plots B and CDE frame the east-west route from Camley Street to Wrotham Road.

## The Triangular Park

This view from one of the balconies in Lulworth shows the new park that will be also framed by Plot A on the left and Plot F on the right. The routes around the park will allow for service vehicle access- but will prioritise pedestrian and cycle movement. The park will be planted with trees and 'rain gardens' as well as providing a MUGA for ball games. The tree in the middle will be retained from the existing stock of trees on site on site.

## Agar Place and the Triangular Park

Plots G (on the left) and A (on the right) frame the public route to the triangular park in front of the west façade of Lulworth. The public realm will be well-planted, and emphasise pedestrian and cycle movement over service vehicle access.
