2013/7585/P	15/12/2013 22:31:43	OBJ	I object to this proposal on the following grounds: 1 The detail design is appalling. It is inconsistent with adjacent buildings and the local environment. It is objectional in its lack of respect of the high quality mansion blocks which form the basis of much of the area's architectural heritage. 2 The design disregards the decisions of the Inspector on the previous scheme proposed for this site. 3 The project directly overlooks the occupiers of adjacent houses on Sarre Road which are at a lower level. 4 The developers have taken no regard of the Fortune Green and West Hampstead Neighbourhood Development Forum, a formally recognised body for planning consultation in the area.
