Details required by condition 2 (sample panel of all facing materials) to planning permission (ref: 2011/1828/P) granted on 17/01/2012 for the erection of single-storey building with two basement levels.

Materials:

VM Zinc Plus Quartz-zinc;

Petersen Tegl D72 brick with Flemish bond and white mortar finished with flush bucket handle pointing;

Reclaimed stock brick in Flemish bond with bucket hand joint darkened to match the adjoining boundary wall;

Vastern Timber Finger jointed Sweet Chestnut cladding treated with Sikkens Cetol HLS+ & Cetol filter 7 to enhance the performance of the wood and protection from weather;

Bronze Kicker plate to oak panelling and door;

400 by 600 Limestone tile cladding to planters Mandarin Stone Classic Campione
