3. Description of Proposed Work

Please describe the proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s):

35 Lamb's Conduit St. is 4-storey Georgian house with basement. It is currently divided into 5 flats. The application proposes the re-organisation of the building into a self enclosed basement flat, with a separate family house comprising of ground, 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors. The internal spaces undergo minor spatial re-organisation (such as the removal of non-structural partitions), with no structural works being undertaken within the main body of the house.

The existing poor-quality rear extension is to be replaced with a new extension of the same width, which is continued to meet the back wall of the garden. The new extension is to be flat roofed with brick walls to match the existing rear facade. The extension is on the south side of the rear garden, meaning any overshadowing will affect only the Applicant's property.

The basement flat is to be accessed directly from the street via a new metal staircase introduced into the existing front lightwell. An opening gate is to be incorporated into the railing around lightwell.

The non-original window on the rear facade at 1st floor is filled in to match with existing brickwork.

A black-painted, poor quality brick extension was added to the rear in the 1980s. It has no historic or heritage significance and is considered to detract from the Listed house's appearance.

Why is it necessary to demolish or extend (as applicable) all or part of the building(s) and or structure(s)?

The existing extension is unfit to accommodate the proposed kitchen space. It is too small, has poor natural light and ventilation, and creates a difficult level change with the original house. It also detracts from the appearance of the house externally.
