Solid London Stock masonry brick walls, with decorative stucco moulds to window reveals and parapet wall. Brick corbels and stucco cornice work at high level.

The proposed works will not involve the construction of any new external walls

Roof - description:

Description of *existing* materials and finishes:

Timber pitched roof with natural slate covering, sheet lead provided within valley gutters and flashings. Timber escape hatch to main roof with blue mineral felt overings.

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

New timber dormer incorporating additional floor to be constructed from new sustainably sourced and treated timber. Existing undamaged slates are to be reused as much as possible. New lead details will be provided where appropriate.

Painted timber sliding sash windows are present on all upper floors. Timber varnished casement windows are provided on the ground floor as part of the overall shop front

Description of *proposed* materials and finishes:

As part of the works, the existing sash windows will be upgraded to incorporate energy saving measures, though will remain insitu. New vertical windows provided within the dormer to be argon filled uPVC double glazed units with Low-E glazing. Opening metal framed skylights will be provided within the roof area to give maximum light penetration.
