Response:

As a resident of Gate Street I have been without anywhere in the neighbourhood to lock my bike for a long time since building works to Africa House started. Locking my bikes to building railings has resulted in two bikes being vadalized and there is nowhere else nearby to safely lock a bike. I am happy to see that bike hoops are included in the plans and will be re-installed in Gate Street in a new location however I ask that this work takes place first, as a priority prior to the sculpture building commencing rather than something that happens at the end of the project. Obviously planning permission focuses on the sculpture however the bike hoops should not be considered an after-thought. The disruption to Gate Street has been ongoing for such a long that re-installing the bike hoops should not be delayed further and should be prioritized. There are car parking and motorbike spaces nearby in Lincoln's Inn Fields, we have been without safe bike parking for over 2 years now. The bike hoops should be installed immediately. Please consider this and could you please contact me and give me some indication as to the time-frame.

As to plans for the sculpture, thank you. It's a great project which I'm fully supportive of and love Conrad Shawcross's work.
