

EXTERNAL PAVING - METHOD STATEMENT

REPLACEMENT OF THE PAVING TO THE ENTRANCE STEPS

- 1.0 This method statement describes the lifting of the existing stone paving and steps and their replacement in Portland stone
- 2.0 The original wrought iron railings are now set into a concrete kerb instead of the stone paving. The approach now proposed is to retain this modern concrete kerb and the railings insitu . The existing paving [modern replacement] is to be removed and replaced with natural stone [Portland stone] with bull nosed edges to the front steps.
- 3.0 The railings are to be carefully stripped to remove the layers of modern paint and clean off all traces of rust. Replacement finials are to be fitted where these are missing
