Dear Elizabeth Beaumont Cc: Mr Obaite Hope

I refer to my telephone conversation with Mr Obate Hope on 18th September 2013 at 3.45pm regarding the above planning application I reiterate that to date we have received no notification of this planning application.

Our reason for appealing the works of (installation of window bathroom in basement flat) is for none other than safeguarding the children in our care.

I am aware that the window is going to be opaque and will open into their property as Mr Hope told me, however the window is at nursery child height (please see attached photo) in our nursery grounds and because of the nature of the room the tenants are bound to be naked in there at some point which could have serious repercussions for our children. Furthermore as this is a property for let, neither us or the owner will be able to vet that the tenants are not paedophiles or sex offenders and in light of serious cases such as the "Vanessa George case in Little Ted's Nursery". We cannot condone a window for a bathroom at this height in our children's play area as it is our duty of care to safeguard them and we would rather prevent a situation than having to rectify a serious problem.

With the last application which strangely enough we were also never informed of, we conducted a questionnaire with our parents about their views, I attach a few copies of the questionnaire and will send all of the hard copies in the post to you.



We are writing as parents of a two year old child who attends Chaston Nursery School, Chaston Place, requesting that the proposed bathroom window for 25 Grafton Terrace not be allowed.

I am absolutely mortified at the thought of a window at child's height being inserted into the outside play area for several reasons that compromise the health and safety of not only for our son but all the children at the nursery school.

I have chosen this setting for my son as I was impressed with the level of safety and protection the children were being given. I feel and so do several other parents that I have been talking to that a window for a room of this nature will obviously have a very high potential of exposing the children to nudity, Also if the window is to be of single plate glass as the rest of the property it could also have catastrophic consequences if broken and lastly that and children are very inquisitive to things that open and the residents of the property also have the potential risk of all types of things from grass to toys being thrown into the bathroom at no fault of the nursery.

I strongly object to having this window as the consequences to the children's safeguarding is detrimental and in view of all the horrific incidents of perversion surrounding children over the recent years, how can the safety of my son and the other children attending the nursery be guaranteed when I have the understanding that it is a let property.


