Details of the boundary treatment to Montagu Place, and hard and soft landscaping including the vehicular lift in relation to condition; 15 parts iv & v, of planning permission granted on: 13/01/2010, ref: 2009/4643/L & 2009/4638/P, for: Demolition of Nos. 1&2 Montague Place and Book Bindery, alterations to the facades of the North Range and King Edward Building, internal alterations to the North Range and Great Court, and hard and soft landscaping works all in connection with the erection of 5-storey building (plus 3 basement levels) with roof level plant to provide a special exhibition gallery, logistics bay (accessed via new vehicular lift off Montague Place), collection storage facilities, conservation laboratories, associated offices and management facilities for the British Museum (Class D1).
