The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed storage area within the front lightwell would represent an incongruous feature that would cause harm to the setting of the host building and its heritage value as a positive contributor, and would fail to preserve or enhance the character and appearance of the wider Belsize Park Conservation Area, contrary to policies CS5 (Managing the impact of growth and development) and CS14 (Promoting high guality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy; and to policies DP24 (Securing high quality



design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.
