
## Source map scale - 1:1,250



These maps were the fore-runners of digital mapping and so provide detailed information on houses and roads, but tend to show less topographic features such as vegetation. These maps were produced at both 1:2,500 and 1:1,250 scales.



# Large-Scale National Grid Data Published 1991 - 1995 Source map scale - 1:1,250


