


WIN-50, existing historic timber windows and ancillary finishes to be refurbished & draught proofed

## Notes:

2-6 Southampton Row is a Grade 2\* listed building and is protected under Historic Building Legislation.

Hatch denotes the existing historic fabric. Any works carried out to modify or make good must be done in a careful and workmanlike manner causing as little impact upon the historic fabric as required for the purposes of the work.

Existing fenestration and form varies, new secondary glazing to match existing openings

For existing windows with little, to no reveal, clarification required as to the requirement for secondary glazing. Any such addition subject to Local Authority approval.
