**Response:**

I wish to object to this application on the following grounds:

- it attempts to justify the existing unacceptable, most probably originally illegal structure, which already harms the streetscape, creates precedent for filling-in spaces between the tall buildings, limits ventilation of the street and has no place next to the existing elegant 1850-s terraces forming the street;
- the proposal attempts to further enlarge the existing structure, thereby further aggravating the existing unacceptable situation;
- the proposal is not aiming to enhance or preserve the Conservation Area, quite the opposite - it will further erode the integrity of the terrace.

By granting Planning Consent for this proposal LB of Camden will contradict its own Conservation Areas policies and will contribute to the architectural vandalism evident in many grotesque roof dormer extensions on the Belsize Crescent dating from the 60's and the 70's
