Our main issue concerns the construction process.

We are immediately opposite the proposed development site. We have several businesses all centred around Recruitment. One of our divisions does Board-level Executive Search. We employ 15 people many of whom spend a lot of time on the phone. We have frequent visitors who come to our offices to be interviewed.

I cannot conceive how the proposed structure can be built in Pratt Mews while the other businesses in the Mews continue to operate.

The demolition and spoil removal, followed by a huge number of material deliveries and massive construction noise not to mention dirt and dust will surely make the street unsafe, and non-viable for an office based-business such as ours.

As the Applicant mentions in the proposal, the Mews is a very constricted space with barely enough room for two small cars to pass each other.

I would not be surprised if the only solution is for us to leave during the build. [And since we are not unsupportive of the proposed new structure, we are open to discussion.]
