We have no objections to the erection of front and enlarged rear dormer with balcony, or side extension, but we do object to the creation of a roof garden and terrace. This may not be seen from street level but will be seen by residents in buildings opposite in Steele's Road, who will have their views over London blocked. Allowing permission would also set a very bad precedence. The thought of further gardens/terraces, with deckchairs and umbrellas, along the roofs of this fine Victorian conservation area terrace is appalling - the uniform look of the entire roofscape would be compromised. The owners will enjoy views over London from the rear dormer balcony.
