E.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with 1 standard ash in the same place.

T1 Holm Oak.Reduce canopy by approximately 20%, reducing overlong

branches by approximately 2-3m to form a more compact continuous canopy.

Thin throughout the canopy by 10%. Remove major deadwood exceeding 25mm in diameter.

The above works are to allow more light into the garden and maintain the current canopy size, and create a continuous canopy outline by bringing in overlong branches. T2 Sycamore. Reduce canopy by height by approximately 4-5m. Due to dieback of one of the major stems. Reduce lateral branches by 2-3m.

A large section (stem) has died back within this tree. The proposed works are to remove the deadwood and then reduce the remaining stem to form a more compact balanced canopy.

T3 Sycamore. Reduce canopy height by 2-3m, reduce lateral growth by 3-4m.

The above works are to allow more light into the garden and maintain the current canopy size.
