The application site is located on the east side of the Highgate Road, between Croftdown Road to the south, Brookfiled Park to the west and St Albans Road to the north. It falls within the Dartmouth Park Conservation Area.

Assessment

Proposal

The continued use of a single storey flat-roofed porta cabin structure, located at the southern boundary of the site. The building measures 9.6m in length, 5.8m in width and approximately 2.8m in height, although it is constructed on bricks at one end due to the difference in ground levels. The structure has four windows on three of the elevations and one set of double doors, with steps leading up to the entrance on the northern elevation.

Design

The proposed location of the cabin is in an area adjacent to an extension of the original listed building. It is in the middle of the site located behind the large building which fronts the Croftdown Road elevation. This location is not considered to harm the setting of the listed building. Moreover the extension would largely shield the cabin from general public views from Croftdown Road. Due to the proposed relocation not being visible from the streetscene, the proposed portacabin is considered to be acceptable in this location. It is considered that temporary permission should be recommended as the nature of such a proposal is a temporary measure until the school finalise the new building details. Temporary permission is also considered acceptable in this location as the type of structure is not one the Council is prepared to approve, other than for a limited period, owing to its appearance. The permanent retention of the structure would be contrary to the requirements of the relevant policies of the LDF.

Amenity

It is considered that the structure does not result in a material loss of daylight, sunlight or a sense of enclosure on neighbouring properties, therefore, the structure is considered to be consistent with the LDF.

Conclusion

The proposed continued use of the portacabin is not considered to harm the character and appearance of the Conservation Area or setting of the listed school house, on the basis of it being erected only for an extended temporary period. Thus permission is recommended for a temporary period of no more than 3 years.
